

2026 CAMILLUS SENIOR CENTER DAY TRIPS

Detailed flyers with registration forms are available for each trip. Be sure to read all trip policies on reverse side before signing up for any trip. Town of Camillus residents may register beginning March 2nd and non-residents may register beginning March 23rd. Space is limited to one bus per trip.

Trip #1 – OFF WE GO TO OSWEGO

Enjoy the day exploring Oswego's H. Lee White Maritime Museum and the Safe Haven Holocaust Refugee Shelter Museum. Lunch at Bridie Manor with an ice cream stop at Bev's Dairy Treats on the shore of Lake Ontario. Depart First Baptist Church of Memphis at 9:00 a.m. and return approximately 4:30 p.m.

Cost per person \$80 Non-residents pay \$85

Trip #2 –OKLAHOMA! AT CORTLAND REPERTORY THEATRE

Start the day at the CNY Living History Museum in Cortland followed by lunch at Bob's BBQ. Enjoy an afternoon performance of Oklahoma! at the Cortland Rep Theatre. Depart First Baptist Church of Memphis at 9:15 a.m. and return approximately 5:15 p.m.

Enjoy a Fall day at Beak and Skiff Orchards picking apples, sampling cider and spirits, and shopping in the General Store. Lunch at their cafe followed by a visit to Skaneateles Historical Society. Depart Camillus Park at 9:30 a.m. and return approximately 4:30 p.m.

Trip #7 – DICK CLARK'S COUNTDOWN TO CHRISTMAS SHOW @ TURNING STONE CASINO

TRIP POLICIES

- Trips offered by the Town of Camillus Senior Center are available to all seniors age 55+.
- Full payment is due at time of registration.
- Registration is on a first come, first pay basis.
- **Town of Camillus residents may register beginning March 2nd. Non-residents may register beginning March 23rd.**
- A detailed flyer for each trip is available and must be completed. Couples may register on the same form. Full payment, in the form of a check made payable to either Camillus Sr. Center must accompany registration form.
- No postdated checks will be accepted.
- Credit cards are accepted in the senior center office. Each transaction is assessed a charge.
- Participants must have an updated yellow registration card on file with the Sr. Center office.
- **SENIORS WITH LIMITATIONS MUST SIGN UP WITH A COMPANION (55+) WHO IS WILLING AND ABLE TO ASSIST.**
- Driver gratuity is NOT included in price. An envelope will be passed on bus to collect gratuity. Suggested gratuity is \$2-\$5 per person.
- Please note that trips are non-transferable. If you are unable to attend, you must notify the center office. The center will fill any vacancies from the wait list, if a wait list is available. Refunds, if granted, will be issued through the town and may take up to three weeks.
- Cancellations received prior to the trip departure will be refunded minus the amount of any non-refundable expenses incurred by Camillus Senior Center. No refund will be given for cancellations or no shows on the day of the trip.
- **PARKING FOR TRIPS IN MAY – AUGUST: First Baptist Church of Memphis, 1960 W. Genesee Turnpike, Elbridge, NY.** Parking is at your own risk.
- **PARKING FOR TRIPS SEPT – DEC: Camillus Park, 1 Camillus Pool Rd (near Orchard Village)** Parking is at your own risk.
- Every effort will be made to return at the designated time, however, delays may occur.
- Camillus Senior Center reserves the right to make changes to the itinerary.
- Reservations are confirmed upon receipt of full payment, space permitting. No verbal reservations will be made. Receipts will be sent via email if an email address is on file.
- Every effort will be made to accommodate those with limitations, however, we cannot guarantee a specific seating location.
- For venues with assigned seating (i.e. theaters), please indicate on trip reservation form with whom you will be traveling so we may seat you together.
- For your safety, “doggie bags” are NOT recommended. Food spoilage may occur in food unrefrigerated for more than 4 hours. If you must, please use thermal containers with proper ice packs.
- Please have an emergency contact available and on standby should you become ill on the trip and need to be picked up.
